WORKING SAFELY AT HEIGHTS

This course brochure will inform and guide you through the Master Builders Working Safely at Heights training course. Please read the following information carefully to help you understand all the course requirements and assessments to ensure that this course is suitable for your needs.

ABOUT US

Master Builders Association of NSW is a Registered Training Organisation (RTO 6163) registered by the Australian Skills Quality Authority. Master Builders offers nationally recognised qualifications and courses across New South Wales which meet endorsed industry standards. Pathways to qualifications include full training and assessment, assessment towards Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), gap training and Continuous Professional Development (CPD).

COURSE OVERVIEW

The Working Safely at Heights course is an invaluable program for anyone currently working in or new to the building and construction industry to gain knowledge in being able to prevent themselves and others from heights related injury. Undertaking the Working Safely at Heights course ensures that the risks associated with falling from heights are highlighted and safety precautions are implemented.

A suitable candidate for this course is anyone working in the construction industry who enters a construction site.

LOCATION AND DURATION

The course is delivered in a classroom over one day from 8:30am to 4:30pm. Visit <http://skillassessment.com.au/courses> for the latest course information.

Courses are run **every Friday** at the Master Builders Education Centre in Baulkham Hills and can also be delivered on-site if suitable areas are available to complete practical assessments.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no educational entry requirements for this course however participants must:

- Be at least 15 years of age
- Have a Valid White Card (general construction induction card) issued after September 2009
- Be proficient in spoken and written English, as assessments must be undertaken in English
- Bring original identification on the morning of the course

COURSE MATERIALS

Participants are not required to bring any materials or purchase specific books to complete this course. A pen and notepad for individual note taking is recommended. Master Builders will provide all course materials, resources and access to PPE (if required) on the training day.

NATIONALLY RECOGNISED TRAINING



Participants who successfully complete this course, will be issued a Statement of Attainment for the nationally recognised units of competency:

- CPCCCM2010B Work safely at heights
- CPCCOHS2001A Apply OHS requirements, policies and procedures in the construction industry

COURSE DELIVERY AND ASSESSMENT

This course covers the following topics:

- Hazard reporting
- Harness inspection
- Communicating with others
- Use of anchor points

This course is delivered and assessed face-to-face in a classroom with:

- Written assessments including a knowledge questionnaire consisting of short answer questions to be completed individually by the participant to obtain evidence of underpinning knowledge needed to work safely at heights.
- Practical assessment conducted one-on-one or in a small group. Where a small group is assessed, the assessor will ensure all aspects of assessment are clearly assessed for each participant in the group (this may involve tasks being completed more than once to ensure each participant is competent).
- Participants will also be assessed on their observable behaviour including oral questions to assess technical criteria relevant to techniques required for this unit of competency.

Participants are provided with a briefing of what is required to successfully complete the assessment; to ensure they are completely aware of the conduct of assessment as well as the required skills, knowledge and behaviour the assessor is looking for within the assessment.

Participants are offered multiple opportunities to demonstrate knowledge and skills throughout the program. At the completion of all the assessment tasks the participant will be provided feedback on their abilities and responses.

CERTIFICATION

If a participant is assessed as 'Competent' in this course, they will progress to the Master Builders certification process for the Statement of Attainment of CPCCCM2010B Work safely at heights and CPCCOHS2001A Apply OHS requirements, policies and procedures in the construction industry as described in the Participant Handbook.

If a participant is assessed as 'Not Yet Competent' in this course they will not receive a Statement of Attainment. They are invited to re-enroll into the course again any time, at the full course fee.

FEES AND CHARGES

Information about Master Builders fees, charges, refunds and withdrawals is provided in the Participant Handbook which is available on our website. The fee for this one day course is:

- \$299 per person for Master Builder's Members
 - \$399 per person for Non-Members
- All fees are GST exempt

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

Whilst undertaking this course, participants must wear closed footwear and appropriate clothing suitable for a work environment (no thongs, singlets, shorts etc).

UNIQUE STUDENT IDENTIFIER (USI)

Any person undertaking nationally recognised training in Australia is required to have a Unique Student Identifier (USI). Master Builders cannot issue a Certificate or Statement of Attainment to a participant who does not have a USI. Master Builders will request the participant creates their USI prior to course commencement. If this is not possible Master Builders have facilities at their training centres for the participant to create their USI prior to course commencement with the assistance of Master Builders' staff.
