RESIDENTIAL BUILDING BASICS (Skill Set Course Three)

Who is this skill set course for?

If you have successfully completed all nine units of competency within the following courses with TAFE NSW, you are eligible to apply for enrolment with Master Builders NSW (RTO 6163) for the remaining seven units of competency which awards the full CPC40110 Certificate IV in Building and Construction (Building) qualification.

- ✓ Residential Building Basics (Skill Set Course One) - Site Safety, Plans, Specifications, Codes and Standards
- ✓ Residential Building Basics (Skill Set Course Two) - Contract Management and Administration

What does this skill set course cover?

This skill set course covers the basics of residential building, including site surveying and set-out procedures, builder's quantities and estimates, structures and material handling, and managing finance. Seven units of competency from CPC40110 Certificate IV in Building and Construction (Building) will be delivered.

What are the entry requirements?

- Successful completion of all nine units of competency of the CPC40110 Certificate IV in Building and Construction (Building) qualification with TAFE NSW
- Minimum of five years full-time (or equivalent) experience in the building and construction industry
- Valid White Card (general construction induction card)
- You live or work in NSW
- You are an Australian citizen or Australian permanent resident or a humanitarian visa holder, or a New Zealand citizen

How much does this skill set course?

This program is subsidised by NSW Government under the Smart and Skilled initiative.

Once we have received your application, Master Builders will obtain an estimated fee from NSW Government and provide a quote prior to your enrolment.

CPCCB4018A	Apply site surveys and set-out procedures to building and construction projects
CPCCB4004A	Identify and produce estimated costs for building and construction projects
CPCCB4005A	Produce labour and material schedules for ordering
CPCCB4006B	Select, procure and store construction materials for low rise projects
CPCCB4010B	Apply structural principles to residential low rise constructions
CPCCB4011B	Apply structural principles to commercial low rise constructions
BSBSMB406A	Managing small business finance

A general guide to government-subsidised fees for this qualification pathway are as follows:

If you do not hold a previous qualification	from \$1,340.00
If you do hold a previous qualification	from \$1,570.00

Master Builders NSW (RTO 6163) can offer Smart & Skilled places for Sydney and Newcastle residents only. Places are limited.

Payment of a \$1,000.00 enrolment fee (ex GST) is required upon enrolment, and remaining fees are due one month after qualification pathway commencement.

Self-Funded Fee (non-government subsidised)
